NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Physician Assistant Board (Board) has proposed that modifications be made to proposed regulations related to application, exam scores, addresses and records in the California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 16, Division 13.8, which would amend sections 1399.506, 1399.507, 1399.511, and 1399.530, and repeal sections 1399.535, 1399.536, 1399.538, 1399.539, 1399.546 and 1399.556. These regulations were originally noticed by the Board on February 23, 2026, and approved as modified by the Board at its August 14, 2026, meeting.
